Deadline for abstract submissions: May 30th, 2025

We are accepting submissions on the following key themes:

1. Clinic & Research

• **Examples:** Novel therapeutic approaches and drug development, advances in phototherapy and topical treatments, combination therapies and personalized medicine.

2. Al & Medtech Innovation

• **Examples:** Al-assisted assessment/diagnostic tools and skin imaging, telemedicine and remote patient monitoring, integration of Al with existing clinical workflows.

3. Cosmetics & Camouflage

• **Examples:** Advances in skin camouflage products and techniques, cosmetic tattooing and micropigmentation, safety and efficacy of makeup and cover-up products.

4. Mental Health and Management

• **Examples:** Psychological impact of vitiligo across different age groups and skin tones, counseling and peer support programs, mindfulness, cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT), and resilience training

- Abstract Length: Maximum 250 words
- Format: Background, Methods, Results, and Conclusion
- **Deadline:** May 30th, 2025, 11:59 pm EST
